

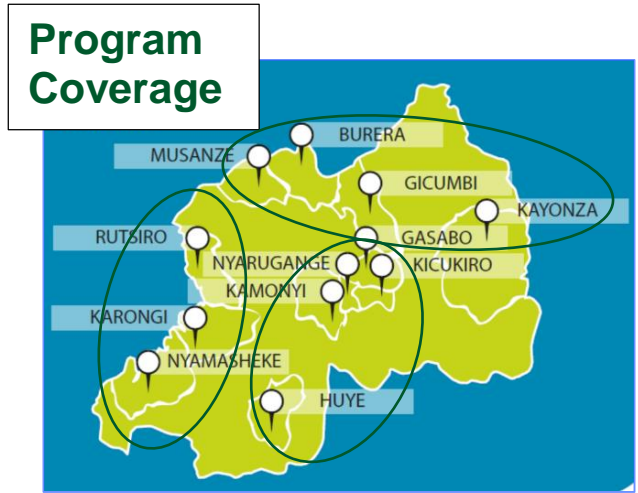
USAID Twiyubake

Global Communities is implementing the five-year USAID / PEPFAR funded Improved Services for Vulnerable Populations (ISVP) Program, known locally as USAID Twiyubake, with the goal of assisting 50,000 vulnerable households (around 250,000 children, youths and adults) in 12 administrative districts.

USAID Twiyubake will use a family centered approach aimed at reducing economic vulnerability, empowering parents to make investments to meet the unique needs of young children and adolescents, and providing health promotion and clinical-community linkages, in a process that the Government of Rwanda and local organizations can sustain over time.

Caritas is implementing the program in Rutsiro district.

USAID Twiyubake program covers 12 districts and 92 sectors, and is divided into 3 zones.



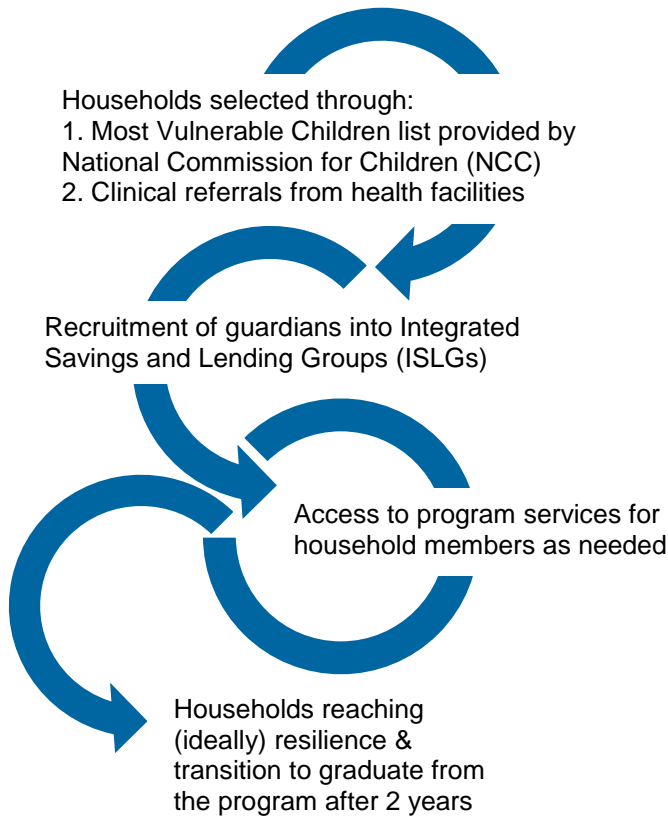
Expected results

1. Families & communities provide healthy, nurturing, and engaging environments for vulnerable young children.
2. Adolescents transition safely into adulthood.
3. Family economic vulnerability decreased.
4. Communities provide essential preventative and protective services to vulnerable families and children.

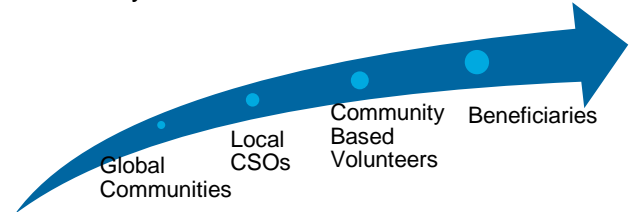
